There are no legislative nor industry guidelines that restrict or ban Copper Beryllium Alloys.

The following products, delivered by Lamineries MATTHEY SA, contain a limited amount of lead (Pb):

Regarding the amount of lead (Pb), all the above mentioned items are exempted from the requirements of Article 4(1) annex II of the directive 2011/65/EC (RoHS). In all cases, the lead content is below the limits of the annex III, points 6a, b, and c of this directive.
